Welcome to the Kwantlen Faculty Association Multimedia Art Contest!

We want to hear YOUR story on how post-secondary education has transformed your life, and we invite **Kwantlen students, alumni and employees** to tune into their inner artist and join us in celebrating the transformative power of post-secondary education!

We will be awarding over \$30,000 in cash prizes within several different categories. This contest is being run by the Kwantlen Faculty Association and sponsored by the Federation of Post-Secondary Educators of British Columbia.

CONTEST SNAPSHOT

Our Multimedia Art Contest has two components: a visual component and a written component.

1. Create an artistic piece that visually communicates a message on “the transformative power of education.”
2. Support the visual message with a one page (maximum!) narrative that tells your story of personal growth and transformation. How has post-secondary education transformed your life?

The visual component can be in any medium (poster, painting, sculpture, photography, collage, video etc.), Winning submissions will be digitized and shared as part of FPSE’s Open The Doors campaign, and contest winners will be invited to provide a brief synopsis of their story at our awards ceremony.

CONTEST ADJUDICATION

This contest will be adjudicated by an interdisciplinary panel constituted from Kwantlen’s internal and external community.

CONTEST GALA

Contest winners will be invited to tell their stories and showcase their art at a “gala celebration” on The Transformative Power of Education in later March 2017.

ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to all currently registered Kwantlen students, Kwantlen alumni and Kwantlen employees (faculty, staff, and administration, including retired employees).

Additionally, all contest participants must be the age of majority in British Columbia (age 19) or have parental or guardian consent to participate in the Contest if the entrant is under the age of majority.

Adjudication Panel evaluators and their immediate family members are not eligible to participate in this contest.
